## Looking for a pain free installation? Try this ...

- 1 Do not cut plastic cable ties
- 2 Only lift the ceiling rose 20cm. Do not raise the rings.
- Turn the ceiling rose over so the bundled cables hang correctly. If there is a twist go back and turn again until the ceiling rose has bundled cable hanging without a twist.
- 4 Raise the box and contents to the ceiling.
- 5 Make the electrical connection.
- Fix to the ceiling, (leaving a temporary 1cm gap between bracket and ceiling may make levelling easier). Your choice.
- 7 Lower the packaging and the rings will hang without twist.
- 8 Each ring has two braided suspension cables and a 2-core flex. If you have created a tangle remove the two braided suspension cables from the ceiling rose and thread the ring back through to remove the tangle.
- 9 Push each of the 18 suspensions up to achieve the designed hanging design. Push the clutch in to release (lower) the suspensions.
- 10 If you are stuffing lots of wire back into the ceiling rose consider lowering the ceiling rose to make this easier.
- 11 Excess braided suspension cables can be cut. Do not be tempted to cut the 2-core wire unless you are happy to rewire the power supply.
